BY GRACE ARE YE SAVED. Ephesians 2:8,9.

Note:

These verses call attention to four things which we would like to consider. They are:

1- Salvation is by grace through faith.

2. Salwation is not of one's self.

3. Salvation is the gift of God.

4. Salvation is not of works.

The Bible emphasizes certain conditions that must be met before one can be saved. There is such a hathing as conditional giving. We consider:

1. The brazen serpent. Numbers 21:4-9.8 21:1-9

 (a) God had a great blessing to bestow on Naaman. God determined to bestow that blessing when certain conditions were met. They were: Dipping in Jordan seven times. Conditions met...Blessing received.
