- 1. A church of strong conviction as to the Truth of the Gospel.
 - 1. They had faith in Christ. Eph.l:;5-16.
 - 2. They endured boldness in teaching and preaching the Gospel. Acts 19:8.
 - 3. They tried and proved false teachers.

 Rev. 2:6.
- 2. They were diligent in teaching and studying the Truth.
 - 1. Publicly and from house to house they were taught. Acts 20:20.
 - 2. They heard Paul daily in the school of Tyrannus for two years. Acts 19:9:10.
- 3. When they learned the fruth they burned their books that had to do with curious arts which they had used. Acts 19:19.
- 4. The Ephesians church was amissionary church.
 Acts 19:10:

"And this cintinued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks." Assos, Smyrna; Pergamos; Sardis; Philidelphia; Loadicea; and others grew out of the work in Ephesus. It leads one to aske not, "How much must I do", nut, "How much can I do".
