1. A succession of moral axioms or of pious admonitions.

Founded upon experience THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST IS: 1. It is a series of facts, empirical facts, pertaining to the Person, life, death, and resurrection of Christ.

THE BACKGROUND OF THE LESSON:

- 1. Peter and John went up to the temple at the hour of prayer. Verse 1, Acts 3.
 - 2. Acertain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid at the gate of the temple whihe is called Beautiful. V. 2
 - 3. This man would ask alms of them that entered into the temple... Verse 3, Acts 3.
 - 4. Peter, with John, said, "Ldok on us". V. 4.

THE LAME MAN:

- 1. He had been a cripple all of his life.
- 2. He was above forty years old. act 4:22
- 3. So this lesson might be entitled, "Life begins at forty."

FOUR THINGS THIS MAN NEEDED: 1. Friendship. Mark 5:19.

- 2. Sympathy. Examples of sympathy: 1. Josus weeping. John 11:35. 2. The weeping widows. Acts 9:39.
- 3. Health. 1. Aeneas of Lydda. Acts 9:32-34. 2. The blind man. John 9:1-38. 4. A SAVIOUR: To meet the paralysis of human need ... freedom from sin.
