1. Information rather fragmentary.

- 2. Those of Acts 6 may have served as deacons.
- 2. DIAKONOS THE GREEK WORD THAT DESIGNATES

1. Minister, Servant, attendant primary meaning.

2. The word used of Christ in Romans 15:8.

3. In this sense any one ministering, serving, or attending might be called a deacon.

3. THEIR QUALIFICATIONS

Must be GRAVE.
 Sedate and dignified. Sober-minded

2. NOT DOUBLE TONGUED

- 2. Two faced. Speaking one thing out of one corner of his mouth...something else out of the other corner. A man of no fixed, decided purpose. James 1:8
- 3. NOT GIVEN TO MUCH WINE

 Not a drunkerd, tippler, or one acting in anyway (conversation-conduct) as if her were under the influence of wine,

4. NOT GREEDY OF FILTHY LUCRE...NO LOVER OF MONEY
1. Earning money in the wrong way.. Working at some

job that is wrong within itself.

5. HOLDING THE MYSTERY OF FAITH IN A PURE CONSCIENCE
1. They must be sound in the faith.

2. Conscientious in maintaining it.

6. THE HUSBAND OF ONE WIFE

1. They must have avoided polygamy and divorce.

7. RULING THEIR CHILDREN AND OWN HOUSES WELL
