## ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CHURCH IN EPHESUS.

- 1. Paul would have gone to Ephesus in the beginning of second tour. Acts. 16:6,7.
- 2. Paul visited in Ephesus briefly at the close of second tour. Apts 18:19-21.

  1. They be sought him to stay. Verse 20.

  2. Paul promised to return. Verse 21.
- 3. Paul spent three years in Ephesus. Act. 20:30
- 4. From Ephesus Paul wrote the first letter to the Corinthians. 1 Cor. 16:8-9.
- For a time Timothy labored with the church in Ephesus. 1 Tim. 1:3
   It is thought generally that John spent the closing years of his life at Ephesus.
- 6. Paul's first visit found the Ephesians interested and willing to learn. Acts 18:20
  "When they desired him to tarry longer time with them, he consented not."

  1. Paul was run out of most places.
- 7. Appollos was Ephesus and here Priscilla and Aquilla "taught him the way of the Lord more perfectly." Acts 18:24-28.

1. He was informed about Jesus but misinformed as to subject of baptism, knowing only the baptism of John. Acts 18:25.
