1. HISTORY OF INCOME TAX

1. First requested in 1815 for war of 1812. Not levied 2. Income Tax 1861-1872 (Federal) levied to pay for the Civil War. (Some States Northern and Southern

had income taxes during 1861-1872) 3. In 1894 an attempt to revive the income tax. Ruled unconstitutional by Supreme Court. 4. Federal Income Tax of 1913 imposed a graduated tax of 1 per cent on incomes of \$3,000 upward.

5. Tax increased by WAR REVENUE ACT OF 1917. On all incomes above \$5,000. 6. REVENUE ACT of 1928 increased taxes. Increases since
