

(LESSON 11) 1 Cor. 14:34,35; 1 Timothy 2:13-15. Lesson taught in the Auditorium Class at Liberty Hill on Wednesday night.

1. Paul's prohibition or not permitting a woman to teach:
 1. "I suffer not a woman to teach..."
 2. Nor to usurp authority over the man...
 3. But to be in silence."

2. His reason for this prohibition.
 1. Adam had priority in creation: "For Adam was first formed, then Eve. 1 Tim. 2:13. Gen 2:7
 2. Gen. 2@18: "It is not good that the man should be alone: I will make him help meet for him."
 3. Gen 2:21-24. Woman made and brought to man.

3. The Sin of Adam and Eve. Which committed the greater sin?
 1. She took of the fruit thereof, and did eat
 2. She gave also unto her husband with her: and he did eat. Gen.3:6

4. About their sin:
 1. "And Adam was not deceived..."
 2. "But the woman being deceived was in the transgression." 1 Tim.2:14
 3. Both sinned:
 1. Eve was deceived.
 2. Adam was not deceived. Why was adam not deceived?
 3. Eve got her prohibition to eat the fruit from Adam.
 4. Adam got his straight from God. Gen.2:16, 17
 5. If we can speak of the GREATER of two sins I think that I would say here that the greater sin was on Adam.
 1. Being not deceived he must have walked into his sin with his eyes wide open.

4. THE SOURCE OF THE TEMPTATION:
 1. Eve's temptation came from the serpent described as "the more subtil of any beast of the field which the Lord God had made." Gen. 3:1
 2. Adam's temptation came for the "help meet" which the Lord God had made for him.
 3. Adam yielded to conjugal love. He should have been the leader.

A BLESSED ASSURANCE FOR WOMAN

1. "Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing." 1 Tim. 2:15
 1. This great and noble work (childbearing) is possible only to motherhood.
 2. Some one commented that this might be called pre-eminently "the child-bearing" for through woman the Christ, the world's Saviour was born.
 3. In this way the great promise was fulfilled which brought a gleam of hope into the darkness of Eve's dispari, "The seed of the woman shall bruise the serpent's head." Gen. Gen. 3:15

2. "If they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety." 1 Tim. 2:15
 1. I do not think that "childbearing" is the penalty but rather the pain that accompanies childberth.

WOMAN'S EXCELLENCIES: Her very excellencies with finer sensibilities and the stronger impulses of a noble and loving nature disqualify her for the headship.
