Luke 17:32; 9:62.

1. Doubtless designed to teach many lessons:
 1. The danger of disobedience. Obedience would have saved her; disobedience (Rom proved her ruin. Heb. 2:2; Eph. 2:2; 5:19.
 2. The folly of delay. Acts 9:38; Ps. 119:60
Acts 22:16. *I made haste and delayed not to keep this commandment*
2. Four Special Lessons:
 1. The difficulty of saving a good man.
1 Peter 4:17, 18. A moral man places his trust in his morals.
 2. The ability of God to Punish Sin.
 1. David's sin and the choice that he had. 2 Sam. 24:13, 14; Heb. 10:31.
 3. The Danger of Looking Back.
 1. Lot's Wife. Gen, 19:26; Luke 9:62.
 2. Here men are admonished:
 - (a) To be earnest and sincere, seeing it is their life for which they flee.
 - (b) To beware of backsliding, since he who looketh back is not fit for the kingdom of God. Luke 9:62
 - (c) To indulge in no delay, since so long as one continues in the plain of his natural condition he stand in imminent peril.
 - (d) To persevere until he reaches the mount of salvation in Christ Jesus
 4. Possibility of being nearly saved; *get*
wholly lost. mark 1:2:28+34
