NEGLECT: Latin: Neg-not; legere-to pick up. Not
to pick up...Let alone.

NEGLIGENCE:

- 1. Causes more than a 100,000 to lose their lives every year in the United States.
- 2. The farmer who neglects seed sowing time will look in vain for a crop at harvest.

PROVERBS 24:30,31; Solomon says, "...I went by the field of the slothful, are by the vineyard of the man void of understanding; And lo, it was all grown over with thorns, and nettleshhad covered the face thereof, and the stone wall thereof was broken down."

WHEN A PREACHER MOVES TO A NEW PLACE HE IS GOVEN A BOOK (church directory) CONTAINING A LIST OF THE MEMBERS. Usually there are three kinds:

- 1. Those regular in attendance 2. Those irregular in attendance.
- 3. Those who do not attend at all.
- GOD'S LIST IN THE BOOK OF LIFE IN HEAVEN.
