 - 2. To surrender one self to a carnal and luxurious course of life.
 - 2. Having damnation because: Versel2
 1. They cast off their first faith. NOT:
 - (1) Not their faith to their first husbands.,
 - (2) Not their promise to remain, (if they made such promise to their first husband) in widowhood. BUT:
 - (3) They have cast aside their simple faith in Christ. HOW DID THEY DO THIS:
 - A. By not walking according to it.
 - B. Their conversation, MANNER OF LIFE, no be-
 - coming their profession of it.
