- 1. Commonly called works of charity to the poor.
 - 1. Not saved by these works only.
 - 2. There will be no doubt many on the right hand who were never in a position to feed the hungry or clothe the neked.
 - 3. They were objects of charity themselves, fed and clothed by others.

 - 3. A believeing regard to Jesus Christ. Col. 3:17
