Seven things which the Lord hates:

1. A proud look.
 - (a) Pride at the bottom of all disobedience and rebellion.
2. A lying tongue.
 - (a) Downright falsehood: the most shameless and shocking of all.
 - (b) Insinuation: the most cowardly and dispicable of all.
 - Latin:* (c) Prevarication: Utterance of a half truth. *To walk crookedly / To speak loosely*
 - (d) Acted untruth: As hurtful as any.

3. Hands that shed innocent blood: Those who by their heartlessness in family, social, church life, crush the spirit and shorten the life.
4. A heart that deviseth wicked imaginations.

5. Feet that be swift in running to mischief.
 - (a) Those who take a savage delight in being the instruments of punishment.
6. A False witness that speaketh lies.
 - (a) One of the most solemn and responsible positions a man can occupy is the witness-box.

7. He that soweth discord among brethren.
 - (a) Men that disturb harmony. Matt. 5:9
 - (b) This is bad: (1) in social circle; *worse* (2) In home; (3) in the church. *worst.*
