1-Tongue: Noun--An organ of the floor of the (webster) mouth; protrusible and freely movable.

2-In the 4th chapter of the book that bears his name, James identified the tongue as follows:

1-The tongues is a little member fo the body.

2-The tongue boasteth great things.

3-The tongue is a fire.

4-The tongue is a world of iniquity.

5-The tongue defileth the whole body.

6-The tongue setteth on fire the course of nature.

7-The tongue is set on fire of hell.

8-The tongue can no man tame.

9-The tongue is an unruly evil.

10-The tongue is full of deadly poison.

- 3-So the theme of our lesson, "SINS OF THE TONGUE"
- 4-A man may sin with his tongue against himself. and seriously injure his own success in life. 1-Some one has said:

2-Let loose the word, and you have let loose the passions.

3-An unbridled tengue is an unbridled nature.

4-Unchecked speech is unchecked wickedness.

- 5-A man may sin with his tongue against God. 1-He may misrepresent God-2-2He may misrepresent the truth of God-3-He may misrepresent God's people. (Preachers be careful) Osen sput in hell)
- 6-A man may sin with his tongue agains his neighbor.

1-The tongue is more destructive than fire.

2-Its scandals spread with greater rapidity.

3-It consumes that which other fires cannot touch. "The tongue is a fire ... and setteth on fire the coures of nature; and it (the tongue) is set on fire of hell."

"Sins of the Tongue." Psalms 120:1-7.

7-When a man, with his tongue, sins against his neighbour it is slander. SO THE GUILT OF;

1-SLANDER:

1-The slandered injures himself ... "The tongue defiles the whole body." 1-He is injured because he has lost the con-

fidence and love of his neighbour.

2-Slander is uncontrollable, "The tongue can no man tame."

1-It set on fire the wheel of birth which catches fire as it goes, and burns with a fiecer conflagration as its own speed increases.

8-You may tame the wild beast;

1-You may arrest the conflagration of the American forest.....

9-There is one thing which you cannot do: 1-You cannot arrest the progress of that cruel word which you uttered carelessly

9-That careless word:

1-Will go on slaying.

2-Will go on poisoning and burining.

3- As the wind swept fire of the prarie it will continue to spread beyond your control, NOW AND FOREVER MORE.
