## THE MARKS OF A FOOL ECCLES. 10:1-3 Buffornery

- 1. The fool hath said in his heart there is no God. Psalms 14:1; 53:1. are matthew 5:21,22 Toal; want of miston; steeped fool; bet sportate
- 2. Folly, (FOOL) foolishness constitutes an unsafe guide. Why?
  - 1. Because the fool's heart is in the wrong place.
  - 2. The fool's heart never acts at the right time.
  - 3. The fool's heart always leads in the wrong direction. He lacks wisdom with whihe to direct.
- 3. Folly invariably betrays its onw stupidity. He will proclaim himself to be a fool:
  - 1. By his irrational behaviour.
    - 1. His wisdom will fail him at critical times and on important subjects.
  - 2. In the most public manner. As he warks by the way.
    - 1. He may be so gone that he is not even conscious that he is making shuch a display of himself.
  - 3. To the trulfest extentent. Not to his friend in private.
    - 1. To his neighbours in the street. "As walkethopythhe way."
    - 2. Not merely to one or two of his neighbors but, "to every one of them."
