  3. That the anxious seeking after these temporal blessings is a characteristic of Pagan life. "For after
- 4. That the anxious efforts for the temporal supplies of the future, in the case of Christ's disciples, are entirely unnecessary. "For your heavenly Father knoweth." Verse 32
- 2. THREE THINGS SUPPORT THE ABOVE FACTS:
  - 1. THE CHARACTER OF GOD. HE IS OUR FATHER AND KNOWETH OUR NEEDS.

    1. If our wants are not supplied by him it must be
    - for one of three reasons:
      1. He has not the capacity...God that Made World.
    - 2. He has not the dispostion. Jesus represented as Our Father.
    - 3. He is not aware of them. Christ said, "He knoweth that ye have need of all these things."
  - 2. THE CHARACTER OF RELIGION. "Seek ye first the kingdom of God...."

    1. If a man is a Christian he will have necessary
    food. It will come to him in a natural way...not
    a miraculous way.
  - 3. THE CHARACTER OF THE FUTURE. "Tomowrow shall take thought for the things 1. Tomorrow will bring its ownfblessings.
