- "WORK TOGETHER FOR OUR GOOD." How?
- They shall co-operate; they shall mutually contribute to our good.
 - 1. They take off our affections from this world.
 - They teach us the truth about our frail transitory, frail condition.
 - 3. In teaching us these lessons they produce:

 A subdued spirit and a humble temper.

- 2. A patient, tender, and kind disposition. Psalms 119:67; Heb 12:11
- 2. The Limits of this promise: "To them who are the MAMMMI called according to his purpose." V-28
 1. They are called, They have answered the call.
- 3. To Others these same afflictions may prove otherwise:

1. They may receive such afflictions as bitter chastisement. If so:

1. They produce murmuring instead of peace.

They produce rebellion, instead of submission.

 They produce anger, instead of calmness, patience and love.
