


“THEN COMETH THE END”

1 Cor. 15:24

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, *rightly dividing the word of truth.* (2 Tim. 2:15)



- The trumpet shall sound at an unexpected time determined by God (1 Cor. 15:52, Mk. 13:32, Matt. 24:44, 1 Thess. 5:2-3)
- Jesus will descend from heaven with a shout (1 Thess. 4:16)
- Those who sleep in Jesus will God bring with him (1 Thess. 3:13, 4:14)
- The dead will be raised, with the dead in Christ rising first (John 5:28-29, Acts 24:15, 1 Thess. 4:16, 1 Cor. 15:52)
- All will stand before the judgment seat of Christ to bow their knee and be judged, with some receiving eternal life and the others receiving indignation and wrath (2 Cor. 5:10, Rom 2:6-8, Heb. 9:27)
- Those righteous who are alive will not sleep but will be changed and will meet Christ in the air to join those righteous who were raised, and so shall we ever be with Jesus (1 Cor. 15:51, 1 Thess. 4:17)
- The kingdom will be delivered to God (1 Cor. 15:24)
- The earth will be destroyed (2 Pet. 3:10)
