3. THE MURDEROUS PLOT OF ENVY.

- 1. If there be no law sufficient to crush; envouse men will make one. That decree was:

 1. Whosoever shall ask a petition of any God or man, save of thee, O king...
 - 2. The duration of that law: FOR THIRTY DAYS.
 - 3, The penality of that Law: (Dan. 6:7)
 1. He shall be cast into the den of lions.

4. ENVY'S POWER TO DESTROY.

1. No tender or humane feeling can dwell in the same breast with envy.

2. Envy will gradually banish every virtuous occupant of the heart, and introduce instead the basest crew.

3. Envy will endeavour to hide her her final intentions.
