SELF-SATISFACTION. Meaning:

1. Satisfaction with one's self. 2. Satisfaction with one's position.

3. Satisfaction with one's power.

4. Satisfaction with one's person... Attainment.

THE RESULT OF SELF-SATISFACTION.

- 1. Divine displeasure is declared against those who are self-satisfied ... who are at ease when they should be at work. Matthew 21:28-32; John 6:28,29.
 - 2. Self-satisfaction leads to self-indulgence. Gratification of fleshley lusts. Gal. 5:19-21; 1 Peter 2:11; Gal. 6:8.
 - 3. Self-Satisfaction leads to Indifference. 1. INDIFFERENTISM: Indifferent to what is true or false. Good or Bad. 2. A want of interest, earnestness, sincerety.

4. Self-satisfaction leads to Neglect.

1. 1. NEGLECT: Literally means, NOT TO PICK UP. To be remiss in attending. To disregard. Acts 6:1; 1 Tim. 4:14; Hebrews 2:1-3.

SELF-SACRIFICE. Meaning:

1. To make sacred.

2. Destruction or surrender of some desirable thing to a higher object ... GOD.

3. Anything consecrated to and offered to God.

THE RESULT OF SELF-SACRIFICE.
